SPIRITUAL GIFTS SURVEY

INSTRUCTIONS

This survey consists of a number of statements about ideas, attitudes, and behavior that may or may not be true about you. Each statement should be evaluated as to whether it is truly representative of you or not.

For example: "I would rather read the book than see the movie."

Your choice ranges from 1 through 7 as to whether or not this is true of you: an answer of 1 means, "It is NEVER true of me;" an answer of 7 means "it is ALWAYS true of me." Try to stay away from 3, 4, & 5 in your selections, instead, use 1, 2, 6 & 7 as much as possible.

This is not a test. There is no right or wrong answer. Your choice in each instance must be made in terms of what you really like and how you feel at the present time. Your choices should be a personal description of your own true, personal inclinations. Do not answer in terms of how you **think** you should respond or how you **want** to be, but in terms of how you **instinctively are**.

Make one choice for each statement. Try to respond objectively to each statement without trying to second-guess the objective. Don't linger too long over the statements. Your first impression is usually the best.

Finally, you may notice that there are two spiritual gifts that are not a part of this test: they are the gift of tongues and the gift of interpretation of tongues (see 1 Corinthians 12:10, 28; 14:1-25). Inasmuch as these gifts are self-evident if present, there is little point in trying to diagnose whether you have these particular gifts or not. But also know that these are precious, God-given gifts (Greek, *charismata*) meant to build up the believers and their absence in this test IN NO WAY diminishes either their importance or place in the Church today.
